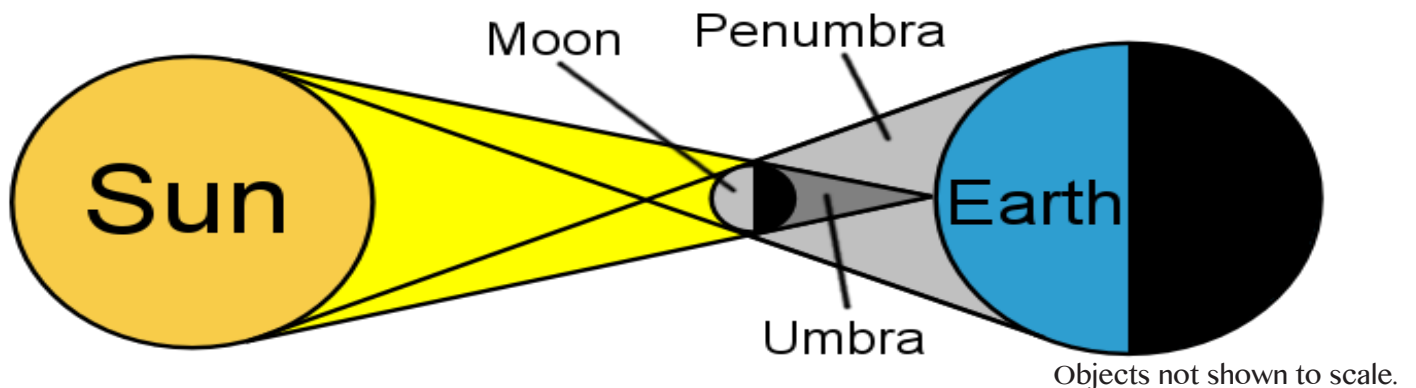

The solar eclipse taking place on Monday, August 21 will be a total global eclipse, but in the Dunlap area it will be viewable only as a partial solar eclipse. The event will begin at 11:50 am, reach its maximum at 1:17 pm, and then end at 2:41 pm. Total duration time will be 2 hours and 51 minutes.

The last solar eclipse viewable from Dunlap was a partial eclipse on October 23, 2014. The next solar eclipse viewable from Peoria will be on October 14, 2023.

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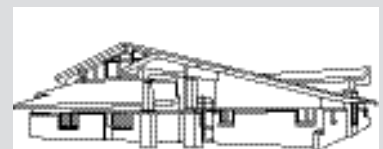
