- 1. The Director may make Procedures for the appropriate use of the Study Room by Patrons and Staff.
- 2. Dunlap Public Library's Study Room is open during normal hours of operation to organizations and/or individuals engaged in educational, cultural, intellectual, social or charitable activities. Such organizations should support the Library's mission to provide materials and services for the educational, informational, social and recreational needs of the community.
- 3. The Library reserves the right to limit use of the room to encourage the broadest possible use by many organizations.
- 4. Permission to meet at the Dunlap Public Library does not in any way constitute an endorsement of the group's policies or beliefs.
- 5. The Library reserves the right to revoke permission to use the Study Room at any time as a result of any prior disorderly, disruptive, or inappropriate behavior.
- 6. This room is also used as a storm shelter.
